Who: Based on an assessment of needs, 40 at-risk youth, ages children 8-17, will be served through either individual equine-assisted psychotherapy sessions or social-emotional learning groups.

Where: The Osage Corral in Albany, Ohio

When: The programming will run from June 2nd through Aug 13th

Cost: The program is fully funded through generous grants from Epstein Teicher Philanthropies and The Sammy and Solly Fund
